

EDITORIAL GUIDELINES FOR AUTHORS OF „LITTERARIA COPERNICANA“

[1] MAIN GUIDELINES

We kindly ask you to follow the guidelines below while preparing your manuscript:

- **main text:** file format *.rtf lub *.doc (Word 97 or a newer version + special fonts, e.g. Greek, Hebrew, Chinese etc.);
- **font size:** 12 points, Times New Roman;
- **line spacing** 1,5;
- **emphasis** – spaced-out text; no bold or underline;
- **quotes:** a short quotation (up to 3 sentences) can be put it in the main text; the longer ones (more than 3 sentences) should be extracted from the main text (size 11, line spacing 1); no indentation in the new line of the main text after such quotes;
- **first name and surname** should be used in the main text (while first appearance);
- **headings, subheadings** should be boldfaced
- **no fixed spaces and line breaking (or word wrapping) acceptable;**
- **bibliographic references** should be included in the text; **footnotes** are allowed only in case of including any additional information or commentary;
- **page range** should be marked with “en dash” (–), not with a hyphen (-), e.g. „(McKanzie 1998: 11–34)“; the same rule should be used in range of years e.g. „in years 1867–1899“
- no shortening of page/years rage is allowed e.g. „25–29“ is correct, but „25–9“ is incorrect;
- **illustrations/photographs/figures** – all illustrations (JPG, TIF – at least 300 dpi) should be provided with appropriate captions, i.e. short description of photo content, source and author of the illustration;
- **tables, charts etc.** should be numbered, titled and have an information about their source;
- generally, **no illustrations, charts etc. from Internet are acceptable** (only public domain materials may be published with

the prior approval of editorial board); **all text fragments, illustrations, drawings, charts, tables etc. coming from other sources are copyrighted** – publication of such materials will be possible after previous submission to the editorial board the copyright holder's written permission by the article author;

- author's name should be followed by a footnote with a short (2-3 lines) **biographical note** of the author, including information about authors title/academic position, academic affiliation, main research interests, as well as the actual email address.

Remarks:

1. Initial *hamza* (') is not marked as *ana*.
2. Particles: *wa-*, *fa-*, *ta-*, *bi-*, *li-*, *ka-*, *la-*, *sa-* and *a-* are attached to words with „-“ e.g. *bi-qalam*, *wa-urīdu*, *wa-al-fikriyya*; *li-al-baḥt*; *li-ad-dirāsāt*.
3. Assimilation of „sun letters“ is also marked e.g. *an-nawm*.
4. Feminine words in *status constructus* have ending *-at* e.g. *madīnat an-nabī*.
5. *Nisba* (-iyyun) is marked as *-ī* e.g. *nabī*
6. *Madda* is marked as a connection *'ā* e.g. *Al-Qur'ān*
7. Word *بن / ابن* is always transcribed as *Ibn* and capitalized e.g. *Ibn Maṣṣūr*; *'Abd Allāh Ibn Maṣṣūr*.
8. Proper nouns are capitalized: *Al-Qāhira*, *Al-Ġāhiz*. If any proper non consists of a few words, the definite article in next elements is written with a small letter e.g. *Al-Ġumhūriyya al-'Arabiyya as-Sūriyya*, *'Abd al-'Azīz*.
